We ask for your help in ensuring that the rules below are observed so that Deutschstunde Inc. works well for everyone. Terms & Conditions apply to all families participating and enrolled in this program.

Parents / Carers are responsible for supervising their own children.

We are a community that believes in ensuring the safety of staff, parents, helpers, guests and children. We respect others and their property. Please remember that we are guests at the PLC – children should not be in /on flowerbeds and walls. We also ask that adults remind other people's children of the rules below if danger is present.

You are responsible for supervision of your child during drop off and pick up times.

- Please drop off and pick up your child on time for their class.
- Please ensure your child has been to the bathroom before class.
- You must keep your child at home if they feel unwell or have any Covid symptoms.
- Please do not bring toys or food to the classroom.
- Children are expected to be attentive in class and always try their best.
- Homework is an integral part of language acquisition and must be done regularly. Parental support is encouraged to provide an overview of their child's progress and to intensify lesson content.
- Please keep all Deutschstunde books including pens in a big document folder, bag or similar and bring to each lesson.
- Wandering the PLC premises or usage of the playground facilities is not allowed for parents and siblings.
- Throughout the year, student evaluation is ongoing and class changes may be suggested.
